SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT BEST PRACTICES FOR CABINETWORK

USE LESS ENERGY

- ightarrow Hire an expert to assess your energy consumption, and learn more about alternative energy solutions.
- ightarrow Install electronic thermostats and set them to drop the temperature after hours.
- \rightarrow Choose energy-efficient appliances (e.g., *Energy Star*).
- ightarrow Swap out your lightbulbs for more energy-efficient models, like LEDs.
- \rightarrow Look into using waste biomass for heating.

MANAGE YOUR WASTE EFFICIENTLY

- → Hire an expert to produce a report on the waste generated by your organization and develop a waste action plan.
- $\rightarrow~$ Implement the 5 Rs (rethink your needs, reduce, reuse, recycle and reclaim).
- $\rightarrow~$ Set up sorting areas with clear posters to promote proper materials management.
- \rightarrow Get *ICI on recycle* + certification.
- → Learn more about material recovery services (recycling centre, ecocentre) offered by your RCM or municipality, or a material recovery business.
- \rightarrow Learn about best packaging solutions for shipping (ecodesign).
- $\rightarrow~$ Look into circular economy opportunities to recycle your wood waste .
- \rightarrow Proactively optimize design to minimize waste.
- \rightarrow Provide durable, reusable personal protective equipment.
- → Offer employee trainings on best practices in CRD (construction, renovation, demolition) waste management.
- $\rightarrow~$ Assess the possibility of robotizing or automating operations to reduce waste

SAVE WATER

- \rightarrow Install devices to reduce water flow during renovations (e.g., toilets, faucets).
- ightarrow Use environmentally friendly, phosphate-free cleaning products.
- $\rightarrow~$ Set up a rain barrel and use the rainwater collected to water plants and other landscaping elements.
- $\rightarrow~\mbox{Provide}$ bottle refilling stations to encourage employees to use reusable bottles .

MAKE RESPONSIBLE PURCHASES

- \rightarrow Adopt a responsible purchasing policy.
- ightarrow Educate your suppliers about reducing packaging.
- ightarrow Shop local, sustainable products (e.g., wood turpentine).
- $\rightarrow~$ Use wood from CRD projects or forest cleaning operations.
- ightarrow Buy wood from FSC-certified forests.
- \rightarrow Choose eco-friendly varnishes, glues, paints, etc.

REDUCE YOUR GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS (GHG)

- ightarrow Hire an expert to assess your carbon footprint and draw up a plan to cut and offset emissions.
- \rightarrow Install charging stations for electric vehicles.
- → Encourage collective and active transportation by installing bike racks and incentivizing carpooling.

IMPROVE WORKPLACE WELLNESS, **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

- ightarrow Make sure your facility is equipped with a high-quality airflow system and provide employees with personal protective equipment for their health.
- \rightarrow Keep a defibrillator and first aid kit accessible onsite.
- \rightarrow Have a first aider present at all times (as required by the CNESST).
- → Review the ergonomics of different workstations and implement recommendations.
- \rightarrow Respect your employees' and coworkers' right to disconnect.

INCREASE CUSTOMER SATISFACTION AND COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

- → Share your sustainable development successes.
- → Ensure that physical access and services are tailored to customer with reduced mobility.
- \rightarrow Sponsor sports and cultural events.
- \rightarrow Get involved in causes.
- ightarrow Set up partnerships with local businesses, artists and artisans (e.g., donating wood waste).
